
In order for Dealer Daily to function efficiently, please configure the Internet Explorer (IE) settings with the following information:

- 2) Browse to the Dealer Daily site you regularly use.




4) From the Tools menu select Internet Options.




5) From the Internet Options dialog box, select the **General** tab.





Update Settings for Stored Pages

- 1) From the Browsing history section, click the  button.




- 2) The Temporary Internet Files and History Settings dialog box displays. Ensure that **'Every time I visit the webpage'** is selected.




- 3) Click the  button to accept the changes.


Set Dealer Daily as a Trusted Site

- 3) Click on the **Sites** button.





- 4) Uncheck **'Require server verification (https:) for all sites in this zone'**.



5) Add the following addresses using the  button:

- *.uotdealereducation.com




6) After the addresses are created, click the  button to confirm the settings.


Disable Pop-up Blocker for Trusted Sites

1) From the Internet Options dialog box, select the  tab.

2) Ensure that Trusted Sites is selected and click on the  button.





- 3) Scroll through the list to the **'Navigate sub-frames across different domains'** option. Ensure it is selected.





- 4) Scroll through the list to the **'Use Pop-up Blocker'** option. Click the **Disable** selection.

Note: this setting applies only to the sites in the trusted list.




- 5) Click the  button to confirm the settings.

- 6) A warning pop-up displays. Click the  button.




Enable Access to Partner Sites

- 1) From the Internet Options dialog box, select the **Privacy** tab.
- 2) Click the **Advanced** button.



- 3) Click to check **'Override automatic cookie handling'**. Then select **'Block'** under Third-Party Cookies and check **'Always allow session cookies'**. Ensure that **'Accept'** under First-party Cookies is selected.






Regular Maintenance: Delete Temporary Internet Files


Deleting Temporary Internet Files is not a required setting but helps all websites run more efficiently. This should be performed monthly.

- 2) Browse to the Dealer Daily site you regularly use.


- 3) From the menu select

- 5) From the Internet Options dialog box, select the  tab.





- 6) From the Browsing history section, click the  button.




- 7) The Delete Browsing History screen displays. From the **Temporary Internet Files** section, click the  button.
